**ED SANDERS TO SPEAK AT LANDMARK COLLEGE**

**Putney, VT – April 10, 2007**

Nationally recognized writer Ed Sanders will be reading from his poetry at Landmark College on Thursday, APRIL 19th. Regarded as a member of the counterculture and recognized as a Beat poet, he has written in a variety of genres and won numerous awards for his publications, including a Guggenheim and NEA poetry fellowship. Also known for his musical talents, he was a member of “The Fugs,” a folk-rock band known for its provocative lyrics and anti-Vietnam sentiments. Mr. Sanders was honored with the prestigious American Book Award in 1988 for *Thirsting for Peace in a Raging Century, Selected Poems 1961-1985*. His poetic style has been linked to Walt Whitman, William Blake, and Allen Ginsberg.

The reading will take place in the East Academic Building from 7:30 until 9:00pm
