**Landmark College Students to Discuss  
“Learning Differently”**

**PUTNEY, VT. – March 10, 2008 – Landmark College students will host the third annual forum, “*Stories from the Inside: Living and Thriving with Learning Differences*”, intended to assist students (middle-school or older), parents, educators, and interested professionals in gaining a perspective about the educational challenges faced by students with learning disabilities or AD/HD.**
