**Landmark College Student Forum:
“Stories from the Inside: Living and Thriving with Learning
Differences”**

PUTNEY, VT. – March 30, 2009 – For the fifth year in a row, Landmark College students will participate in a program intended to assist middle and high school students, parents, and educators gain perspective about the educational challenges faced by students with learning disabilities or AD/HD.

The program, perhaps the only one presented entirely by students with learning differences, offers a first-hand perspective into the challenges and triumphs of overcoming learning differences. The afternoon will begin with a short keynote address and a brief overview of the various one-hour sessions being offered.

Landmark students will discuss a variety of topics including living with LD and ADHD, social-emotional challenges, time management and organizational tools, and academic strategies that work. We recommend that students who attend should be in middle or high school. There will be time for audience questions during each session and refreshments will be served.

The program will take place on Sunday, April 19th, in the East Academic Building Auditorium, Landmark College, beginning at 2:00 pm.

The public is invited and admission is free.
