AU	Audited a course
Extension	issued by instructor with prior approval of the Academic Dean to indicate that the student is continuing to work on course requirements for an extra semester without penalty in final grade
IP	In Progress; issued by an instructor of EN0911, EN1011, EN1015, FY1001, FY1011, MA0291, MA0392, or MA1501 when a student has earned a grade of D+ or below
W	Withdrawn from course (student's progress not specified at time of withdrawal)
WP	Withdrawn from course (passing)
WF	Withdrawn from course (failing)
