Update sent to students, faculty, and staff via e-mail

Hello,

As you likely know, the incidents of influenza-like symptoms are emerging on campuses around the country. Landmark College has closely monitored local and national health advisories concerning the H1N1 flu virus, and is prepared to respond to any suspected cases of the flu on campus.

At this time, there are no confirmed cases of the H1N1 influenza on campus.

Today, however, one student came to Health Services with symptoms of influenza. We are not yet able to confirm if the illness is caused by H1N1. Test results are expected by Monday.

As our protocol requires, the student is being isolated. The student plans to travel home later this evening.

Classes, Family Weekend events and all other scheduled activities remain unchanged. We will continue to keep you informed and updated as more information becomes available.
