To all students:

The Student Health Service has received an additional supply of H1N1 flu (swine flu) vaccine. The vaccine is free of charge and comes in either nasal spray or injectable form.

The College encourages you and all students to consider being vaccinated as a strategy to protect your own health and the health of the entire community. You may call the Health Service at 6753 to arrange an appointment or to ask any questions you may have. Health Services can help you decide which form of the vaccine would be appropriate for you.

Please note that some doses of vaccine for the seasonal flu are also available at a charge of \$20.00. You can have the cost of that vaccine charged to your student account.
