



### **General Education Goals**

- A. Students who graduate from Landmark College will have acquired the basic language and learning skills required as a foundation for further academic work and the workplace. (BASIC SKILLS AND ABILITIES)
- B. Students who graduate from Landmark College will have developed strategies, processes, and competencies that allow them to read, write, study, communicate orally, and learn effectively at a college level. (COLLEGE-LEVEL ACADEMIC STRATEGIES, PROCESSES, AND COMPETENCIES)
- C. Students who graduate from Landmark College will have developed the self-understanding, self-management strategies, and knowledge of learning disabilities, social policies, political issues, and the law required to work autonomously and successfully in academic settings or the workplace. (METACOGNITION, SELF-EFFICACY, AND SELF-ADVOCACY)
- D. Students who graduate from Landmark College will have developed an understanding of the roles and social norms that affect individuals and communities, as well as lifestyle habits and behaviors that promote effective academic and workplace performance, and developed self-understanding and meaningful goals within the domain of personal and social development. (PERSONAL and SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT)
- E. Students who graduate from Landmark College will be exposed to a liberal arts curriculum and understand and apply the core information, modes of inquiry and overall contexts in the humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, mathematics, communications, and the arts, and apply and synthesize the knowledge they have acquired. (BUILDING A FOUNDATION IN THE LIBERAL ARTS)
