

Admissions Campus Visit Procedure

If you would like to schedule a summer visit to Landmark College, please be aware that we are allowing visits under the following conditions and guidelines:

1. The student has an interest in attending Fall 2020 (if you or your student is interested in attending Landmark College beyond Fall 2020, we will amend these guidelines soon).
2. Campus visit appointment requests must be made at least 48 hours prior to the day of the visit.
3. Only one family visit at a time will be scheduled (one in the morning, one in the afternoon each day. Students may be accompanied by two other family members.
4. Screening: Families will be pre-screened by an admissions counselor by phone prior to their visit and asked to affirm to the following:
 - a. Student and family have been staying home and isolating for the past two weeks.
 - b. Student & family have none of the following symptoms: fever above 100.4 F, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, sore throat, headache, recent loss of taste or smell.
 - c. No one in a student/family household has tested positive for COVID-19.
 - d. The student and family have not been in contact with anyone with COVID-19 in the 21 days prior to their appointment (even if they are non-symptomatic).
5. Once the student and family arrive, they will be greeted outside the Olivier Building (Admissions) and screened again with the above questions and their temperatures will be taken.
6. The student and family members must wear masks upon arrival to our campus and through the duration of their visit. If they do not arrive with a mask, one will be provided to them by the College.
7. Anyone who has not/is not adhering to the above, or who has a temperature of 100.4 degrees or greater would be asked to leave campus.
8. All visitors, their temperatures, and contact info will be recorded.
9. Once the family enters the Olivier Building, they would also be asked to use our hand sanitizer or directed to wash hands in any of the 3 restrooms.
10. While on campus, physical distancing will always be observed (minimum of 6 feet apart).
11. Students and families will be asked to make no non-essential stops while in Vermont. If they are going to enter any establishment, they should wear their masks.
