

To reduce the transmission of COVID-19 and the possibility of acute illness if an individual is infected, Landmark College will require that all employees and students who will be on campus <u>at any time</u> <u>during the fall 2022 semester</u> are up to date with a COVID-19 vaccine (all doses of a primary series plus one booster) by the arrival on campus.

Information on the COVID-19 vaccines available for use is available from the <u>Centers for Disease</u> <u>Control</u>.

Exemptions for medical reasons will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

• Medical exemptions: A medical exemption requires the signature below of a health care practitioner authorized to prescribe vaccines. Students should consult with their healthcare provider about vaccine options and any specific individual recommendations.
